1. **Class "A" (Hotel) License** – authorizes the retail sale on the premises of hotels. The annual license fee for a Class "A" License is Four Thousand Five Hundred Dollars (\$4,500.00). No sales are permitted between 2:00 a.m. and 8:00 a.m. (A license to sell until 4:00 a.m. may be obtained for an annual fee of \$500.00)
2. **Class "B" (Restaurant) License** – restaurants with or without a cocktail lounge. The annual license fee for a Class "B" License is Three Thousand Dollars (\$3,000.00). No sales are permitted between 2:00 a.m. and 08:00 a.m. (A license to sell until 4:00 a.m. may be obtained for an annual fee of \$500.00).
3. **Class "B(1)" (Cocktail Lounge) License** – cocktail lounge without a restaurant. The annual license fee for a Class "B(1)" License is Three Thousand Dollars (\$3,000.00). No sales are permitted between 2:00 a.m. and 08:00 a.m. (A license to sell until 4:00 a.m. may be obtained for an annual fee of \$500.00).
4. **Class "C" (Liquor Store – Package Sales) License** – retail sale on the premises specified of alcoholic liquor in its original package, not for consumption on the premises. The annual license fee for a Class "C" License is One Thousand Dollars (\$1,000.00). No sales permitted between 2:00 a.m. and 11:00 a.m. on Sundays and no sales permitted between 2:00 a.m. and 8:00 a.m. on all other days.
5. **Class "D" (Restaurant Table Service Only) License** – retail sales from a Service Bar to tables in a restaurant. No sales are permitted between 2:00 a.m. and 08:00 a.m. The annual license fee for a Class "D" License is Two Thousand Dollars (\$2,000.00).
6. **Class "E" (Government Facility) License** – sale of alcohol at a Government owned stadium or exposition center. The annual license fee for a Class "E" license is One Thousand Five Hundred Dollars (\$1,500.00). No sales are permitted between 2:00 a.m. and 09:00 a.m.
7. **Class "E" (1) (Entertainment District) License** – Retail sale of alcoholic spirits by the drink for consumption on the premises. A class E(1) additionally allows retail sales of alcoholic sprits by the bottle for consumption within private rooms that are not open to all members of the general public. No sales are permitted between 2:00 a.m. and 08:00 a.m. License Fee is \$3500.00
8. **Class "E" (2) (Entertainment District Special Event) License** – A Class E (2) authorizes a Class E- 1 license holder to engage in the retail sale of alcoholic liquor from one satellite serving area located on the Village owned common outdoor area of The Park at Rosemont Entertainment District. A class E-2 is a temporary license and is valid for a specific date and time period. The fee is \$100.00 for each temporary license.

9. **Class "E" (3) (Entertainment District Brew pub) License** – A Class E (3) authorizes a Class E- 1 license holder to additionally operate, on the licensed premises a "brew pub" as defined in section 1-3.33 of the Liquor Control Act of 1934 (235 ILCS 5/1 – 3.33. **The License Fee for a Class "E" (3) is \$3500.00**
10. **Class "F" (Beer and Wine Only) License** – sale of beer and wine only. Dollars **The annual license fee for a Class "F" License is Two Thousand Five Hundred (\$2,500.00)**. No sales permitted between 9:00 p.m. Saturday and 11:00 a.m. Sunday and between 9:00 p.m. and 9:00 a.m. on all other days.
11. **Class "G" (One Day) License** – sale and dispensing of liquor at facilities owned or leased by the Village of Rosemont or the Rosemont Park District. The applicant must have dramshop insurance, which names the Village of Rosemont as an additional insured. License is valid for one day only. **The license fee for a Class "G" License is Twenty-Five Dollars (\$25.00)**.
12. **Class "I" (Catering)** – permits licensee to deliver and serve alcoholic beverages on the same premises on not more than five days during any 30-day period. An open bottle containing not more than two liters of wine may be placed on a table where food is to be served if wine is intended to be consumed as part of a meal. No sales are permitted between 2:00 a.m. and 08:00 a.m. **The license fee for a Class "I" License is One Thousand Five Hundred Dollars (\$1,500.00)**.
13. **Class "J" (Special Circumstances Extended Hours)** – authorizes the holder of a Class A, B, B(1) or D or E(1) License to sell alcohol for consumption on premises for which the Class A, B, B(1) or D has been issued during hours when the sale of alcohol is otherwise prohibited. A Class "J" License shall not be valid for more than on 24-hour period. A holder of a Class A, B, B(1) or D License shall not be issued a Class "J" License more than twice during any calendar year. **The license fee for each Class "J" License is One Hundred Dollars (\$100.00)**.
14. **Class "K" (License-authorizes for the retail sale on the premises)** specified of alcoholic liquor for consumption on the premises and the retail sale of beer in its original package for consumption off of the premises. No sales are permitted between 2:00 a.m. and 08:00 a.m. **The annual license fee for a class "K" license shall be three thousand and five hundred dollars (3,500.00)**.
15. **Class "L" (Privately Owned Theater)** – authorizes the retail sale of alcoholic beverages on the premises of a movie or live performance theater that is not owned and operated by the Village of Rosemont. No sales are permitted between 2:00 a.m. and 11:00 a.m. **The annual license fee for a Class "L" License is Three Thousand dollars (\$3,000.00)**
16. **Class "M" (Catering)** – authorizes the holder of a Class "A" license to sell alcoholic liquor, where the alcoholic liquor is both delivered and served by the licensee on premises located outside the corporate limits of the Village of Rosemont. No sales are permitted between 2:00 a.m. and 08:00 a.m. **The license fee for a Class "M" License is Five Hundred Dollars (\$500.00)**

17. **Class "N"** License shall permit a licensee to deliver and serve alcoholic liquor on the same premises on not more than one day during any thirty (30) day period. All beer and wine is served by a Class "N" Liquor License holder shall be served in a glass bottle or other container that holds not more than 16 ounces, provided that an open bottle containing not more than 2 liters of wine may be placed on a table where food is to be served. No sales are permitted between 12:00 a.m. and 08:00 a.m. **License Fee \$50. 00 per day.**
18. **Class "O"** Authorizes the holder of a Class "B" license to open and serve previously unopened bottles of wine that are brought to the premises by a customer as part of the customer's purchase of a meal. **The License Fee for a Class "O" is Five Hundred Dollars (\$500.00) in addition to the annual class (B) license.**
19. **Class "P"** Authorizes the holder of a Class "A", Class "B", Class "B(1), Class "D", Class "F", Class "G", or Class "K" to utilize their respective liquor license in a patio or seating area that is not located within the interior of the licensed premises. A class "P" license shall not be issued unless the applicant submits an application which includes (1) written documentation from the landlord of a leased facility which consents and agrees to applicants use of the outdoor area; (2) written proof that the applicant's dram shop coverage includes the outdoor area; (3) a dimensioned drawing showing the outdoor seating area with its relationship to the interior of the premises, adjacent buildings, walkways, drive aisles and parking lots; a safe means of ingress and egress, the use of barricades, railings or similar devices that are at least 3 feet in height to surround the patio or outdoor seating area and serve to hinder entry into the area without the knowledge of the applicant. **License Fee is \$500.00 dollars in addition to the annual fee for any other license that is required.**
20. **Class "S" Wine and Liquor Tasting)** – authorizes the retail sale of alcoholic beverages on the premises specified for the purpose of tasting or sampling said alcoholic beverages on the premises of government owned exposition center or stadium for a period not to exceed ten (10) consecutive days. The license fee for a Class "S" License is Fifty Dollars (\$50.00) per day per location. An applicant for a Class "S" License must submit with the application proof satisfactory to the Local Liquor Control Commissioner that the applicant has made arrangements to provide dram shop liability insurance. The applicant must also provide proof that the required dram shop liability insurance policy names the Village of Rosemont as an additional insured. No sales are permitted between 10:00 p.m. and 11:00 a.m. the following day.
21. **Class "W"** (Wine Tasting with related package sales) Authorizes the holder of a Class "B" License to hold a wine tasting event at which the Class "B" License holder may engage in the retail package sale of bottles of wine presented for tasting during the event. A Class "W" License is a temporary license and shall be granted for a specific date and time period of which it shall not be longer than 5 hours. No Class "B" license holder may receive more than six (6) Class "W" license during any calendar year. **License Fee is \$100.00 per event.**
