The following is a list of the fourteen (14) types of liquor licenses, which the Village is authorized to issue:

1. **Class "A" (Hotel) License** – authorizes the retail sale on the premises of hotels. The annual license fee for a Class "A" License is Four Thousand Five Hundred Dollars (\$4,500.00). No sales are permitted between 2:00 a.m. and 8:00 a.m. (A license to sell until 4:00 a.m. may be obtained for an annual fee of \$500.00)
2. **Class "B" (Restaurant) License** – restaurants with or without a cocktail lounge. The annual license fee for a Class "B" License is Three Thousand Dollars (\$3,000.00). No sales are permitted between 2:00 a.m. and 11:00 a.m. (A license to sell until 4:00 a.m. may be obtained for and annual fee of \$500.00).
3. **Class "B(1)" (Cocktail Lounge) License** – cocktail lounge without a restaurant. The annual license fee for a Class "B(1)" License is Three Thousand Dollars (\$3,000.00). No sales are permitted between 2:00 a.m. and 11:00 a.m. (A license to sell until 4:00 a.m. may be obtained for an annual fee of \$500.00).
4. **Class "C" (Liquor Store – Package Sales) License** – retail sale on the premises specified of alcoholic liquor in its original package, not for consumption on the premises. The annual license fee for a Class "C" License is One Thousand Dollars (\$1,000.00). No sales permitted between 2:00 a.m. and 11:00 a.m. on Sundays and no sales permitted between 2:00 a.m. and 8:00 a.m. on all other days.
5. **Class "D" (Restaurant Table Service Only) License** – retail sales from a Service Bar to tables in a restaurant. The annual license fee for a Class "D" License is Two Thousand Dollars (\$2,000.00).
6. **Class "E" (Government Facility) License** – sale of alcohol at a Government owned stadium or exposition center. The annual license fee for a Class "E" license is One Thousand Five Hundred Dollars (\$1,500.00). No sales are permitted between 2: a.m. and 11:00 a.m.

7. **Class "F" (Beer and Wine Only) License** – sale of beer and wine only. The annual license fee for a Class "F" License is Two Thousand Five Hundred Dollars (\$2,500.00). No sales permitted between 9:00 p.m. Saturday and 11:00 a.m. Sunday and between 9:00 p.m. and 9:00 a.m. on all other days.
8. **Class "G" (One Day) License** – sale and dispensing of liquor at facilities owned or leased by the Village of Rosemont or the Rosemont Park District. The applicant must have dramshop insurance, which names the Village of Rosemont as an additional insured. License is valid for one day only. The license fee for a Class "G" License is Twenty Five Dollars (\$25.00).
9. **Class "H" (Beer and Wine Store Package Sales)** – package sale of beer and wine for delivery. Not for consumption on the premises. The annual license fee for a Class "H" License is One Thousand Dollars (\$1,000.00).
10. **Class "I" (Catering)** – permits licensee to deliver and serve alcoholic beverages on the same premises on not more than five days during any 30-day period. An open bottle containing not more than two liters of wine may be placed on a table where food is to be served if wine is intended to be consumed as part of a meal. The license fee for a Class "I" License is One Thousand Five Hundred Dollars (\$1,500.00).
11. **Class "J" (Special Circumstances Extended Hours)** – authorizes the holder of a Class A, B, B(1) or D License to sell alcohol for consumption on premises for which the Class A, B, B(1) or D has been issued during hours when the sale of alcohol is otherwise prohibited. A Class "J" License shall not be valid for more than on 24-hour period. A holder of a Class A, B, B(1) or D License shall not be issued a Class "J" License more than twice during any calendar year. The license fee for each Class "J" License is One Hundred Dollars (\$100.00).
12. **Class "L" (Privately Owned Theater)** – authorizes the retail sale of alcoholic beverages on the premises of a movie or live performance theater that is not owned and operated by the Village of Rosemont. The annual license fee for a Class "L" License is Three Thousand Dollars (\$3,000.00)

13. **Class "M" (Catering)** – authorizes the holder of a Class "A" license to sell alcoholic liquor, where the alcoholic liquor is both delivered and served by the licensee on premises located outside the corporate limits of the Village of Rosemont. The license fee for a Class "M" License is Five Hundred Dollars (\$500.00).

14. **Class "S" (Wine and Liquor Tasting)** – authorizes the retail sale of alcoholic beverages on the premises specified for the purpose of tasting or sampling said alcoholic beverages on the premises of government owned exposition center or stadium for a period not to exceed ten (10) consecutive days. The license fee for a Class "S" License is Fifty Dollars (\$50.00) per day per location. An applicant for a Class "S" License must submit with the application proof satisfactory to the Local Liquor Control Commissioner that the applicant has made arrangements to provide dramshop liability insurance. The applicant must also provide proof that the required dramshop liability insurance policy names the Village of Rosemont as an additional insured.

VILLAGE OF ROSEMONT
GENERAL REQUIREMENTS AND RESTRICTIONS
FOR LIQUOR LICENSE

1. No person may sell liquor in the Village of Rosemont without having a retail liquor license issued by the President of the Village in his capacity as Local Liquor Control Commissioner.
2. Three (3) copies of the application must be filed with the License Officer.
3. No license shall be issued to the persons or entities listed §4-4(a) of the Municipal Code of the Village of Rosemont.
4. No license shall be issued or renewed if petitioner has violated the Retailers' Occupational Tax Act.
5. The license fee must be paid to the Village at the time of filing the application.
6. All liquor licenses (excluding Class "G" and Class "S" and interim licenses) are for a period of one (1) year.
7. No license is transferable to any party or for any reason.
8. No license shall be issued for sale of alcohol within 100 feet of any church or school, except for hotels or motels offering restaurant service. No license for the sale of liquor for consumption on the premises shall be issued within 100 feet or another such location; except for hotels or motels.
9. There must be a clear view of the interior of any premises from the exterior. All rooms shall be continuously lit (either naturally or artificially) so that there is a clear view.
10. Each licensee shall frame and hang his/her license in plain view.
11. Each licensee must also have a State License issued by the Illinois Liquor Control Commission.
