LIQUOR LICENSE GENERAL REQUIREMENTS/ RESTRICTIONS

- No person may sell liquor in the Village of Rosemont without having a retail liquor license issued by the President of the Village in his capacity as Local Liquor Control Commissioner.
- All liquor licenses are for a period of 1 year. (Exceptions: Class G, N, S and Interim Licenses)
- No license is transferable to any party for any reason.
- No license shall be issued for sale of alcohol within 100 feet of any church or school, except for hotels/motels offering restaurant services.
- No license for the sale of liquor for consumption on the premises shall be issued within 100 feet or another such location. (Except for hotels/motels)
- Each licensee shall frame and display current liquor license in plain view at all times.
- Each licensee must also have State License issued by the Illinois Liquor Control Commission.
- The license fee must be paid to the Village of Rosemont at the time of filing the application.
- No applications will be processed until all necessary requirements are completed and submitted.

LIQUOR LICENSE CLASSIFICATIONS

1. **CLASS "A" (HOTEL) LICENSE-** authorizes the retail sale on the premises of hotels. The annual license fee for a Class "A" License is \$4,500.00. No sales are permitted between 2:00 a.m. and 8 a.m. (A license to sell alcohol until 4 a.m. may be obtained for an annual fee of \$500.00)
2. **CLASS "B" (RESTAURANT) LICENSE-** restaurants with or without a cocktail lounge. The annual license fee for a Class "B" License is \$3,000.00. No sales are permitted between 2:00 a.m. and 8 a.m. (A license to sell until 4 a.m. may be obtained for an annual fee of \$500.00)
3. **CLASS "B(1)" (COCKTAIL LOUNGE) LICENSE-** cocktail lounge without a restaurant. The annual license fee for a Class "B(1)" License is \$3,000.00. No sales are permitted between 2:00 a.m. and 8 a.m. (A license to sell until 4 a.m. may be obtained for an annual fee of \$500.00)
4. **CLASS "B(2)" (KIOSK) LICENSE-** authorizes the retail sale on the premises of alcoholic spirits by the drink and beer & wine by the drink, pitcher, bottle or carafe with or without food service, located within a retail shopping mall. The annual license fee for a Class "B(2)" License is \$3,000.00.
5. **CLASS "C" (LIQUOR STORE-/ PACKAGE SALES) LICENSE-** authorizes the retail sale on the premises specified of alcoholic liquor in its original package, not for consumption on the premises. The annual license fee for a Class "C" License is \$1,000.00. No sales permitted between 2:00 a.m. and 11 a.m. on Sundays and no sales permitted between 2:00 a.m. and 8:00 a.m. Monday through Saturday.
6. **CLASS "D" (RESTAURANT TABLE SERVICE ONLY) LICENSE-** authorizes the retail sales from a Service Bar to tables in a restaurant. No sales are permitted between 2:00 a.m. and 8:00 a.m. The annual license fee for a Class "D" License is \$ 2,000.00.
7. **CLASS "E" (GOVERNMENT OWNED FACILITY) LICENSE-** authorizes the sale of alcohol at a Government owned stadium or exposition center. The annual license fee for a Class "E" License is \$1,500.00. No sales are permitted between 2:00 a.m. and 9:00 a.m.

8. **CLASS "E(1)" (ENTERTAINMENT DISTRICT) LICENSE-** authorizes the retail sale of alcoholic spirits by the drink for consumption on the premises. A Class E(1) additionally allows retail sales of alcoholic spirits by the bottle for consumption within private rooms that are not open to all members of the general public. The annual license fee for a Class E(1) License is \$3,500.00. No sales are permitted between 2:00 a.m. and 8:00 a.m.
9. **CLASS "E(2)" (ENTERTAINMENT DISTRICT SPECIAL EVENT) LICENSE-** authorizes a Class "E(1)" License holder to engage in the retail sale of alcoholic liquor from one satellite serving area located on the Village owned common outdoor area of The Park at Rosemont Entertainment District. A Class "E(2)" is a temporary license and is valid for a specific time period. The annual fee for a Class "E(2)" License is \$500.00.
10. **CLASS "E(3)" (ENTERTAINMENT DISTRICT BREW PUB) LICENSE-** authorizes a Class "E(1)" License holder to additionally operate, on the licensed premises a "brew pub". The annual fee for a Class "E(3)" License is \$3,500.00.
11. **CLASS "F" (BEER AND WINE ONLY) LICENSE-** authorizes the sale of beer and wine only on the premises. The annual fee for a Class "F" License is \$2,500.00. No sales permitted between 9:00 p.m. Saturday and 11:00 a.m. Sunday and between 9:00 p.m. and 9:00 a.m. on all other days.
12. **CLASS "G" (ONE DAY) LICENSE-** authorizes the sale and dispensing of liquor at facilities owned or leased by the Village of Rosemont or the Rosemont Park District. The License is valid for one day only. The license fee for a Class "G" License is \$25.00. ****This application requires additional information to be provided. Please refer to the table listed below for details.**
13. **CLASS "I" (CATERING) LICENSE-** permits the licensee to deliver and serve alcoholic beverages on the same premises on not more than 5 days during any 30 day period. An open bottle containing not more than 2 Liters of wine may be placed on a table where food is to be served if wine is intended to be consumed as part of a meal. No sales are permitted between 2:00 a.m. and 8:00 a.m. The annual fee for a Class "I" License is \$1,500.00.
14. **CLASS "J" (SPECIAL CIRCUMSTANCES EXTENDED HOURS) LICENSE-** authorizes the holder of a Class A, B, B(1), D, or E(1) License to sell alcohol for consumption on the premises for which the Class A, B, B(1), D or E(1) has been issued during hours when the sale of alcohol is otherwise prohibited. A Class "J" License shall not be valid for more than a 24 hour period. A holder of a Class A, B, B(1), D or E(1) License shall not be issued a Class "J" License more than twice during any calendar year. The license fee for a Class "J" License is \$100.00.
15. **CLASS "L" (PRIVATELY OWNED THEATER) LICENSE-** authorizes the retail sale of alcoholic beverages on the premises of a movie or live performance theater that is not owned and operated by the Village of Rosemont. No sales are permitted between 2:00 a.m. and 11:00 a.m. The annual fee for a Class "L" License is \$3,000.00.
16. **CLASS "M" (CATERING) LICENSE-** authorizes the holder of a Class "A" license to sell alcoholic liquor, where the alcoholic liquor is both delivered and served by the licensee on the premises located outside the corporate limits of the Village of Rosemont. No sales are permitted between 2:00 a.m. and 8:00 a.m. The license fee for a Class "M" License is \$500.00.
17. **CLASS "N" LICENSE-** authorizes a licensee to deliver and serve alcoholic liquor on the same premises on not more than 1 day during any 30 day period. All beer and wine served by a Class "N" Liquor License holder shall be served in a glass bottle or other container that holds not more than 10 ounces, provided that an open bottle containing not more than 2 Liters of wine may be placed on a table where food is to be served. No sales are permitted between 12:00 a.m. and 8:00 a.m. The license fee for a Class "N" License is \$50.00/day.

- 18. CLASS "O" LICENSE-** authorizes the holder of a Class "B" License to open and serve previously unopened bottles of wine that are brought to the premises by a customer as part of the customer's purchase of a meal. The fee for a Class "O" License is \$500.00 in addition to the annual Class "B" License.
- 19. CLASS "P" (PATIO) LICENSE-** authorizes the holder of a Class A, B, B(1), D, F, or G to utilize their respective liquor license in a patio or seating area that is not located within the interior of the licensed premises. The annual fee for a Class "P" License is \$500.00 in addition to the annual fee for any other license that is required. ****This application requires additional information to be provided. Please refer to the table listed below for details.**
- 20. CLASS "S" (WINE AND LIQUOR TASTING) LICENSE-** authorizes the retail sale of alcoholic beverages on the premises specified for the purpose of tasting or sampling said alcoholic beverages on the premises for a period not to exceed 10 consecutive days. No sales are permitted between 10:00 p.m. and 11:00 a.m. the following day. The license fee for a Class "S" License is \$500.00 per day per location. ****This application requires additional information to be provided. Please refer to the table listed below for details.**
- 21. CLASS "W" (WINE TASTING WITH RELATED PACKAGE SALES) LICENSE-** authorizes the holder of a Class "B" License to hold a wine tasting event at which the Class "B" License holder may engage in the retail package sale of bottles of wine presented for tasting during the event. A Class "W" License is a temporary license and shall be granted during specific time period of which it shall be no longer than 5 hours. No Class "B" License holder may receive more than 6 Class "W" License during any calendar year. The fee for a Class "W" License is \$100.00 per event.
- 22. CLASS BYOB LICENSE-** authorizes the holder of a Class BYOB license to allow the consumption of customer's beer or wine brought by the customer and/or guests being of legal age on the premises of the restaurant as a complement to the consumption of a meal purchased from the restaurant. The annual fee for a Class BYOB License is \$250.00.

CLASS "G" LICENSE	Dram shop liability insurance must name the Village of Rosemont as an additional insured. Provide/ attach a copy of insurance with application.
CLASS "P" LICENSE	(1)Written documentation from the landlord of a leased facility which consents to applicant's use of outdoor area. (2)Written proof that the applicant's dram shop liability coverage includes outdoor area. (3)A dimensioned drawing showing the outdoor seating area with its relationship to the interior of the premises, adjacent buildings, walkways, drive aisles and parking lots; safe means of ingress and egress, the use of barricades, railings or similar devices that are at least 3 feet in height to surround the patio or outdoor seating area and serve to hinder entry into the area without the knowledge of the applicant.
CLASS "S" LICENSE	(1)Submit proof of satisfactory to the Local Liquor Control Commissioner that the applicant has made arrangements to provide dram shop liability insurance. (2)Provide proof that the required dram shop liability insurance policy names the Village of Rosemont as an additional insured
